

Activities of the Government in the Housing Department during last four years (Since May, 2011)

• Providing Shelter to the People belonging to Economically Weaker Section :

Geetanjali is a State Scheme to provide shelter to the People belonging to the Economically Weaker Section of the Society.

In the last four years, of the present Government, benefits have been extended to cover 134884 families against 32340 families during the previous Government.

In addition, 720 flats have been constructed and handed over to WBHIDCO for the distribution amongst the people who were either land looser or Shelter less or the HIDCO project affected Government has set a target of constructing 65000 dwelling units during the financial year 2015 – 16.

- **"PATHASATHI"** : Housing Department alongwith PWD is constructing "PATHASATHI" {(Road Side Motel) having Bathroom, Toilet, Passenger Waiting Room, Night Shelter & Restaurant} at prominent locations on the National Highway, State Highway and other important Roads.

Housing Department is constructing 18 Pathasathis which are expected to be completed by 31/12/2015.

PWD is constructing 51 "Pathasathis" and these are in different phases of construction and all 69 Pathasathis will be under the Housing Department for operation & Maintenance.

• Hostel for Working Women :

Department provides hostel accomodation to the working women who are single as well as low paid.

- **Night Shelter for Patient Parties :** For the benefit of Patient Parties, the Department is constructing Night Shelter within the campus of different Government Hospital in Kolkata, Districts & Subdivisions.

Complete :

- a) N. R. S. Medical College, Kolkata : 100 bedded.

Under Construction :

- a) Medical College, Kolkata : 72 bedded.
- b) Baruipur Sub Division Hospital, South 24-Parganas : 90 bedded.

Up-gradation of Rental Housing Estate for Government Employees : 12191 flats in 104 Housing Estate has been taken up under special repair and up-gradation. Repairs of 22 Estates in Kolkata have been completed. The works in the rest 14 estates in Kolkata will be completed soon.

Department has already Constructed 194 flats in the following districts .

- v) Swayambhara, Salt Lake : 24 flats

- **One Auditorium has been constructed in the campus of Kusthia Public Rental Housing Estate.**

- **All quota system in respect of allotment of flats in RHE & PRHE have been abolished.**
- **A Special Scheme has been introduced to provide residential accommodation in in RHEs and PRHEs as per availability of vacancies to the "Bangabibhusan" awardees who have no accommodation in Kolkata and within 25 k.m. of Kolkata during his/her life time or till he or she acquires any accommodation within Kolkata.**
- **Housing scheme for Government Employees "AKANKSHA" : -**
Department will construct 50000 flats in different towns for its Employees who have no accommodation for themselves at construction cost to cost basis. As pilot project, 576 flats will be constructed at New Town. Applications will be invited during 2015 - 16.
